**DAVOS MEETING**  
**Davos/Switzerland, 09 – 10 January 2010**

The Speed Skating Competitions, consisting of races over four distances, will be held under the regulations of the International Masters Speed Skating Committee (IMSSC) and the Inter-



national Skating Union (ISU). The standard track, 400 meter to the lap, laid out on the Davos open air natural ice rink has the inner and outer curves with radii of 25.5 and 29.5 meters respectively with a warm up track.

No members of national selections or national teams are allowed. \* = Seniors.

- Training** Daily from 10.00 h to 14.00 h
- Liability** The ISU, the IMSSG, the IMSSC and the Organizer assumes no responsibility for your liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property loss or damage incurred in connection with the competitions. Each member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.
- Eligibility** To be eligible the skater must be a member of a national speed skating federation recognized by the ISU and must have a licence of this organization.
- Drawing** **Friday, January 08, 2010, 18.00 h**, ice rink building 1<sup>st</sup> floor.  
**Payment of the entrance fee from 17.00 h** at the same place.
- Neighbourhood five year age groups with only few participants may be put together for drawing and speed skating in the competition. The classification however will be separately in five year age groups (depending on the number of participants). The winner of a contest in a five year age group is the skater who has completed successfully all distances and has obtained the lowest total of points.
- Prizes/Minutes** All participants who skate successfully the four distance contest, obtain a certificate. All participants will receive a protocol with the complete results with starting times, lap times, accumulated lap times and end times.
- Doping control** May be made in accordance with ISU rules.
- Entrance fee** CHF 60,00 (€ 40,00) including an Euro 8,00 fee for the costs of the IMSSC. It has to be paid before drawing (see above at "Drawing").
- Limitation** The competition is limited. The arrival date of the entry will be decisive for the participation, if a limitation of participants will be necessary. You will only be informed through the Internet under

in the Competitors List if you can take part in the competition. The List will, if needed, be actualized weekly.
- Entries** Must be made **only via internet by Electronic Entry on the webpage** [www.imssc.org](http://www.imssc.org) . It is expected until: **December 20<sup>th</sup>, 2009**.  
**Post Entries are possible until Thursday 7 Jan 2010.**
