Eligibility

To be eligible the skater must be a member of a national speed skating federation recognized by the ISU and must have a licence of this organization.

Drawing

Friday, 11 January 2013, 19.00 h, Stiftung Sport-Gymnasium Davos, Gruenistr. 1, Davos-Platz. Payment of the entrance fee from 18.30 h at the same place.

Neighboured five year age groups with only few participants may be put together for drawing and speed skating in the competition. The classification however will be separately in five year age groups independent of the number of participants in the five year age groups. The winner of a contest in a five year age group is the skater who has completed successfully all distances and has obtained the lowest total of points.

Prizes/Minutes The first, the second and the third in every age group receive a small award. All participants who skate successfully the four distance combination, obtain a certificate. All participants will receive a protocol with end times. The complete protocol with starting times, lap times, accumulated lap times and end times you will find on the website of the ISCD www.davos-skating.ch.

Doping control May be made in accordance with ISU rules.

Entrance fee

CHF 60,00 (including an EUR 10,00 fee for the costs of the IMSSC. It has to be paid before drawing (see above at "Drawing").

Limitation

The competition is limited. The arrival date of the entry will be decisive for the participation, if a limitation of participants will be necessary. You will only be informed through the Internet under
