The competition is restricted to 100 skaters (respectively 107 entries; by experience in the beginning of the season about 7 % loss of entered competitors by illness, injuries, etc.).

The criterion for the admission in the competition is the entrance by fax or post of the correctly filled in and signed Entry Form.

The skaters only get informed in the internet www.eisevents-erfurt.de whether they can take part in the competition (list of accepted competitors).

3. Schedule:

3.1. Training:

The training times on Friday and Saturday are incl. the entrance fee. You must pay EUR 15,- per day for training times before Friday. **Please announce in the OC office.**

5. Drawing / Classification:

Neighbourhood 5 year age groups with a small number of participants may be put together for drawing and speed skating in the competition. In these combined groups the age group of each skater will always be mentioned behind his/her name in the protocol. The classification however will be separated in the listed age groups. The winner of the four distances competition in one of the age groups is the skater who has completed all distances with the lowest total of points.

6. Prizes:

To all competitor who succeed the four distances contest obtain a document, a medal and a protocol.

7. Doping control:

Doping test made in accordance to ISU Rule 139.

8. Entries:

Each competitor must send the correctly filled in and signed **Entry Form by fax or post to the OC. E-Mails cannot be considered.** Additionally a correctly filled in and originally signed Entry Form must be handed over at the payment of the entrance fee.

Deadline for the entries: Friday, November 2nd, 2007

9. Entrance Fee:

The entrance fee is **EUR 50,- per person.** This includes a dinner at the reception on Friday evening and EUR 8,- fee for the costs of the IMSSC.

Additional participants in the dinner (coaches, team members or members of the family) pay **EUR 20,- per person.**

A refund is not possible if a competitor does not take part at the dinner. If an additional dinner is ordered by the competitor for companions it has to be paid also if the companion does not take part in the dinner.

The entrance fee has to be paid before the drawing. Announced skaters arriving after the drawing and having confirmed their participation by fax in due time (12 hours before drawing at the latest) have to pay their entrance fee until three hours before the announced starting time of the competition at the first competition day.

The organizer is not liable in any case for skaters, accompanying persons (see ISU rule 119).



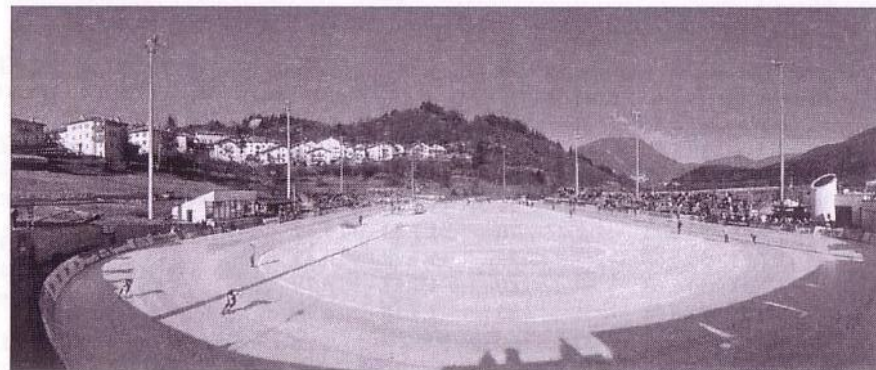

Eligibility

To be eligible the skater must be member of a national speed skating federation recognized by the ISU and must have a license of his/her federation.

Drawing, Classification

Neighbouring five year age groups with small numbers of participants may be put together for drawing and speed skating in the competition (in these combined age groups the age group of each skater will be written behind his/her name in the protocol). The classification however will be done separately in 5year age groups independent of the number of participants in an age group. The winner of the four-distance contest in his/her age group is the skater who has completed successfully all distances and has obtained the lowest total of points in his/her 5year age group.

Recommendation to the competitor

The competitor is recommended to overtake another competitor in the speed skating competition only at the outside if both are in the same track. That minimizes the danger of accidents. There is no ISU Rule that a skater who will be overtaken in a track has to go to the outside of the track. Overtaking takes place very often in races with quartet start.

Prizes and Results

All participants, who skate successfully the competition without disqualification, obtain a certificate, a medal and a protocol with the results including starting times, lap times, accumulated lap times and end times.

The classification however will be separately in five year age groups (depending on the number of participants). The winner of a contest in a five year age group is the skater who has completed successfully all distances and has obtained the lowest total of points.

- Prizes/Minutes** All participants who skate successfully the four distance contest, obtain a certificate. All participants will receive a protocol with the complete results with starting times, lap times, accumulated lap times and end times.

- Doping control** May be made in accordance with ISU rules.

- Entrance fee** CHF 45.00 (€ 30.00) including an Euro 8,00 fee for the costs of the IMSSC. It has to be paid before drawing (see above at "Drawing").
