SD CHAMPIONSHIPS Milwaukee/USA

vs. There was no news here until now from an interesting International Masters' Competition already in January in Milwaukee/USA, the 1st Masters' International USA SINGLE DISTANCE CHAMPIONSHIPS on 08 - 09 Jan 2011. So I wish still to mention here this nice competition organized by Bruce Connor with Olesegun Sijuwade and referee Ernest Kretschmann with their teams. The following distances have been skated: 2 x 500 m, 1000 m, 1500 m, 3000 m and 5000 m. 36 participants (4 Ladies, 32 Men) from 4 Nations (CAN 1, GER 1, ROU 1, USA 33) competed in the US Olympic Training Facility, the nice ice hall of Milwaukee. No IMSSC Records, but a lot of personal bests were reached by the participants. 07 May 2011

1st RUSSIAN SDR Kolomna/RUS

vs. The 1st Masters' International RUSSIAN SINGLE DISTANCE RACES were held in the ice hall of Kolomna/RUS on 01 - 03 Apr 2011 with 125 competitors (32 Ladies, 93 Men) from 6 Nations (BLR 3, ESP 1, GER 1, KAZ 2, NOR 3, RUS 115). For the first time we had skaters from Belorussia at an International Masters' Competition. The following single distances were skated: 500 m, 1.000 m, 1.500 m, 3.000 m, 5.000 m, 10.000 m. The Ladies and Men could skate a 4 Distances Allround Combination 500 m, 1.500 m/1.000 m, 3.000 m, and the Men could skate alternatively also a 4 Distances Allround Combination 500 m, 5.000 m/1.500 m, 10.000 m. At the 3rd competition day Pursuit Races took place, for Ladies 6 laps races and for Men 8 laps races. Four IMSSC Records of the IMSSC Records List 2010 were lowered: Vladimir Kostin/M35/KAZ: 1.000 m 1:13,20 min, 1500 m 1:50,74 min, 4 Distance Allround Small Combination 500 m, 1.500 m/1.000 m, 3.000 m 151,493 points; Boris Repnin/M45/RUS 4 Distance Allround Big Combination 500 m, 5.000 m/1.500 m, 10.000 m 173,739 points. 6 Pursuit Teams Ladies competed in the 6 lap distance. The first ranked Trio with the Members of the AG 40/40/35 reached 3:45,36 min, the fifth ranked eldest Trio with the AG 65/70/70 reached 4:59,15 min. 12 Pursuit Teams Men competed in the 8 lap distance. The first ranked Trio with the Members of the AG 40/45/40 reached 4:21,14 min, the last ranked eldest Trio with the AG 65/70/70 reached 5:39,05 min. More results you find on the websites

8th LONG DISTANCE RACES Heerenveen/NED

vs. At the 8th Masters' International LONG DISTANCE RACES in Heerenveen/NED on 24 Mar 2011 in the Thialf ice hall 53 competitors (4 Ladies, 49 Men) from 5 Nations (FIN 2, GER 2, NED 46, NOR 1, SUI 2) fought on the 500 m and a long distance from 3.000 m, 5.000 m and 10.000 m. 20 skaters skated the 3.000 m, 12 skaters the 5.000 m and 21 the 10.000 m. Ton Kooijmans/M70/NED lowered the IMSSC Record from the IMSSC Records List 2010 over 5.000 m in 8:24,42 min. 4th HEERENVEEN SPRINT/NED

vs. The **4th Masters' International HEERENVEEN SPRINT** took place in Heerenveen in the Thialf ice hall on 22 -23 Mar 2011. **55 Masters (11 Ladies, 40 Men) from 6 Nations (BEL 1, FIN 1, GER 2, NED 47, NOR 2, SUI 2)** skated on the two days in a 4 distance sprint combination 500 m, 1000 m/500 m, 1000 m. **Gerdien Meijer/F45/NED lowered 5 IMSSC Records** from the IMSSC Records List 2010: 500 m 43,40 sec, 500 m 43,25 sec, 1000 m 1:27,44 min, 1000 m 1:25,47, 4 distance sprint combination 500 m, 1000 m 173,105 points; **Barbara Heerschop/F55/NED** 4 distance sprint combination 500 m, 1000/500 m, 1000 m 193,335 points. CHAMPIONS CHALLENGE in Kearns/USA

vs. The 2nd Masters' International CHAMPIONS CHALLENGE in Kearns/Salt Lake City/USA was held 04 – 06 Mar 2011 in the ice hall Utah Olympic Oval. 75 Masters (70 Men, 5 Ladies) from 11 Nations (CAN 3, GER 4, ITA 4, JPN 17, KAZ 2, MEX 1, NED 15, NOR 11, ROU 1, RUS 3, USA 14) competed in the Utah Olympic Oval. Especially the high number of 17 Japanese participants was remarkable. And for the first time we had a participant of Mexico. The following distances have been run in the three competition days on fast ice: 500 m (2 x), 1000 m, 1500 m, 3000 m, 5000 m. A four distance combination 500 m, 3000 m/1500 m, 5000 m was possible. 04 May 2011

10 K WEDNESDAY in Kearns/USA

vs. The 1st Masters' International 10 K WEDNESDAY in the Utah Olympic Oval of Kearns/Salt Lake City/USA took place on Wednesday, 02 Mar 2011, directly in the week after the 20th Masters ALLROUND GAMES in Calgary/CAN and only two days before the 2nd Masters International CHAMPIONS CHALLENGE, also in Kearns/USA. 24 skaters (2 Ladies, 22 Men) from 6 Nations (GER 1, ITA 2, JPN 1, NED 8, NOR 11, USA 1) took part in this long distance competition with distances of 10.000 m or 5.000 m. 17 Men competed at the 10.000 m and 5 Men and 2 Ladies skated the 5.000 m. The relatively best time could be reached by Ragnvald Næss/Men 55/NOR with 14:56,57 min for 10.000 m, only about one second over his own IMSSC Record, which he skated with 14:55,21 in Kolomna/RUS 03.04.2010. ALLROUND GAMES in Calgary/CAN

vs. The 20th Masters' International Allround Games were held on four days 24 – 27 Feb 2011 at the Olympic Oval in Calgary/Canada. 222 Skaters (52 Ladies, 170 Men) from 12 Nations (CAN 63, FIN 2, GER 11, GRE 1, ITA 7, LAT 2, NED 63, NOR 49, ROU 1, RUS 4, SUI 1, USA 18) competed on fast ice. For the first time we had a Greek participant. You find the results on the website of the Olympic Oval of the University of Calgary http://www.oval.ucalgary.ca under "Speed Skating", "Results+" and "Long Track" in the Event Archive 2010/11 and on the website SpeedSkatingNews http://www.speedskatingnews.info/?page_id=813&eventID=19156. During the four days 43 IMSSC Records from the IMSSC Records List 2009/2010 were lowered and a lot of personal best times were reached at the skated distances 500 m, 1000 m, 1500 m, 3000 m and 5000 m. Tony Zegers/CAN and Roy Whitney/CAN, the two eldest participants, skating admirable well in age group Men 80, were honoured by the ISU Masters Coordinator Dr. Volker Serini. Head of the Games Organization Committee was Gregg Planert, who had a lot of work not only on the competition days, but already for the preparation of this event. Together with his team members, a lot of them volunteers, he made a great job. The competition was well guided by the Main Referee Wim Kok and his Jury. The Closing Banquet and the Victory Ceremony were held in the Red and White Club at the McMahon Stadium. They were conducted by **Jock Wilson** with his team in a cheerful and trouble-free manner. The participants had a lot of fun at this evening. Dr. Volker Serini invited the competitors to the 21st Masters' International Allround Games in Erfurt/GER, provisionally on 9 – 11 Mar 2012.

15 Feb 2011

34th IMSSC Session Amsterdam/NED

vs. The 34^{th} Session of the International Masters Speed Skating Committee (IMSSC) will be held on Saturday 28^{th} May 2011 in Amsterdam/NED. Because of a necessary reduction of costs it has to be restricted to one day from 9:00-15:00. Initially it was planned for two days.

14 Feb 2011

8th IMSSG Session cancelled

vs. The 8th Session of the ISU Masters Speed Skating Working Group (IMSSG) on 27 May 2011 in Amsterdam/NED has to be cancelled now, because the IMSSG budget 2011 has not been granted by the ISU Council. The first official information from the ISU Council on 13 Nov 2010 was, that the budget 2011, proposed by the IMSSG, had been accepted by the ISU Council. But after the IMSSG asked for the referral of the promised budget to the IMSSG account on 07 Feb 2010 the ISU informed the IMSSG on 10 Feb 2010 that the budget could only be granted under certain preconditions. These preconditions could not be fulfilled by the IMSSG.

25 Jan 2011

Sprint Games Berlin – a Great Event

vs. **The 3rd Masters' International Sprint Games** were held on 22 – 23 January 2011 in the Speed Skating Icehall of the Sportforum in **Berlin-Lichtenberg**. It was a great event with **209 competitors, 47 Ladies and 162 Men from 16 Nations** (BEL 1, CAN 2, ESP 1, FIN 11, GER 37, ITA 9, KAZ 4, LAT 3, NED 62, NOR 39, NZE 1, RUS 22, SUI 3, SWE 2, UKR 10, USA 2). On very good ice a lot of excellent results were reached. **17 times IMSSC Records** were lowered: **Katrin Zehmisch/GER/L40** Sprint Combination (500 m, 1000 m/500 m, 1000 m) 174,430 points; **Lijnie Boele/NED/L45** 500 m 44,52 sec, 1000 m 1:28,33 min, 500 m

43,62 sec, 1000 m 1:26,87 min, Sprint Combination (500 m, 1000 m/500 m, 1000 m) 175,740 points; Noor van der Steer/NED/F55 Sprint Combination (500 m, 1000 m/500 m, 1000 m) 192,405; Bart Seffinga/NED/M30 1000 m 1:15,39 min, 1000 m 1:14,23 min, Sprint Combination (500 m, 1000 m/500 m, 1000 m) 151,000 points; Vladimir Kostin/KAZ/M30 1000 m 1:14,24 min, 1000 m 1:14.09 min, Sprint Combination (500 m, 1000 m/500 m, 1000 m) 149,845 points; Ivar Niøs/NOR/M45 Sprint Combination (500 m, 1000 m/500 m, 1000 m) 153,910 points; Alf Gjølga/NOR/M65 Sprint Combination (500 m, 1000 m/500 m, 1000 m) 174,445 points; Arne Kjell Foldvik/NOR/M75 Sprint Combination (500 m, 1000 m/500 m, 1000 m) 203,235 points; **Ivan Yuzubkin/RUS/M80** Sprint Combination (500 m, 1000 m/500 m, 1000 m) 245,340 points. At the Welcome Drink after the Drawing in the Official Competition Hotel Kolumbus there was a rich warm buffet for the participants and their coaches and companions. The Victory Ceremony and the following Closing banquet with a large warm buffet also was held in the Hotel Kolumbus. Volker Serini, Coordinator of the ISU Masters Speed Skating Working Group, said a lot of thanks to Jörg Krakow, the Head of the Organization Committee with his small team for their tremendous work and to the main referees Kurt Ney and Melanie Symalla and their large Jury and Competition Office staff who guided the Masters Sprint Games Competition very well. During drawing, welcome drink, competition, victory ceremony and closing buffet the participants of the Masters Sprint Games were in a good mood. Because a lot of skaters from the different nations already know themselves from many other competitions they seem to be a large speed skating family. Visit German Parliament not possible

vs. The 12th Masters' International DAVOS MEETING on 15 – 16 January 2011 at the Eisbahn Davos, the famous natural speed skating icetrack in the Graubünden Alpes at 1560 m above sea-level, has been canceled because of the extremely warm weather this year. This is the first time that the DAVOS MEETING had to be canceled. We hope that in the coming years the weather again will show lower temperatures so that this wonderful competition can again be held.

USA SDC - Milwaukee

vs. The announcement of the 1st Masters' International USA SINGLE DISTANCE CHAMPIONSHIPS on 8 – 9 Jan 2010 in Milwaukee/Wisconsin/USA has been issued now on our website under www.imssc.org/10-Ann-Milwaukee.pdf together with the entry form (non-electronic). Cancelled – Master Cup in Munich

The competition was planned by the Bavarian Ice Sports Federation for Munich instead of Berlin because of the 3rd Masters' Sprint Games taking place in Berlin this season. It was not possible to have both competitions in Berlin.

7th CRITERION Erfurt - Report

vs. The first International Masters' Competition of the season 2010/2011 was held in Erfurt/Germany on 13 – 14 Nov 2010, the 7th Masters' International Speed Skating Criterion. 108 Competitors (29 Ladies, 79 Men) from 5 Nations (GER 28, NED 64, NOR 10, RUS 2, SUI 4) took part in this competition in the nice Gunda-Niemann-Stirnemann-Ice-

Hall. Remarkable was the **proportion Ladies/Men** 12/16 of the 28 German participants. We would wish such or in minimum similar proportions Ladies/Men for all Nations and for all Competitions. The competition was very well organized and very well conducted and the ice was of top quality. So the competition made much fun for the participating Masters. Already at the beginning of the season very good results could be reached, see www.imssc.org/10-criterion-results.pdf. Even **7 IMSSC Records** (Masters' International Records) were broken. **Thea Kroonje/NED/F 65** lowered 5 of them with the following results: 500 m 49,44 sec, 1000 m 1:35,21 min, 1500 m 2:26,21 min, 3000 m 5:00,36 min, Ladies Allround (500 m, 1500 m/1000 m, 3000 m) 195,148 points. And **Bart Seffinga/NED/M 3**0 lowered the other two: 1000 m 1:14,97 min, Men Allround Small (500 m, 15000 m/1000 m, 3000 m) 160,413 points.

19 Oct 2010

Cancelled - SINGLE DISTANCE RACES 2011 in Hamar

vs. The 9th Masters' International SINGLE DISTANCE RACES 2011 in Hamar/NOR, planned for 22 – 23 Feb 2010 in the Vikingskipet, the Viking Ship ice hall, had to be cancelled. One of the reasons was that the 3rd Masters' International SPRINT GAMES in Berlin could not be held on 05 – 06 Feb 2011 as originally planned, but only on the same date, 22 – 23 Feb 2010. We hope that such an incident does not happen next season and that in 2012 the SINGLE DISTANCE RACES in the Hamar Vikingskipet ice hall again can be held.

SPRINT CLASSICS 2011 in Inzell under Proviso
